After their commitments to senior school exams, our Year 6 children have embraced some wonderful opportunities since and this week featured a significant highlight: our Enterprise Fair. Through a series of STRIDE workshops aimed to help the children develop business and marketing plans, groups presented to a panel of judges on Wednesday and then set up their stalls on the front lawn, looking to maximise those profits! I know that our esteemed judges, Mrs Sowah, Mrs Jones and Mrs McCarey, were very impressed with the professionalism and teamwork on show during the pitches, and creativity, energy and business acumen were very much in evidence during the fair. I left with a healthy smoothy, an illustrated rugby bookmark and won a fidget toy! I gather the final totals saw profits of £800.68 from sales, after initial expenditure of £211.70, which would certainly impress Sir Alan Sugar. Thank you to our judges, the Year 6 form teachers and, of course, to Mr Hoo for overseeing this exciting project.

Year 1 have also demonstrated some very creative thinking this week, given my observations of Mrs Lindsay's class assembly all about the environment and re-cycling. The children confidently shared the story of 'Michael Recycle', then quizzed the audience about the time it takes for materials to degrade and how we should change our behaviours to protect the future. The children spoke, sang and acted beautifully and showcased some very dapper re-cycled headwear and eye-catching artwork which might have prompted some ideas for the children involved in next year's Enterprise Fair.

On Tuesday, Year 3 hopped on a coach to head down to Marchants Hill, a PGL centre, for their first ever residential stay overnight south of Guildford. The children tackled all sorts of physical and teamwork challenges, not least the trials and tribulations of making sure the duvet covers and pillows were shipshape for a good night's rest. The Year 3 team were incredibly impressed with the children's resilience, determination and maturity, making the most of this formative experience.

Finally, this afternoon witnessed a brand-new event at TPS – our inaugural Grandparent's Day for Year 2– which saw over 40 guests share some special time with the children before a high tea in the Hall and a chance to say 'thank you'. Events like this emphasize the key values we espouse of being 'Courteous' and 'Considerate' at all times, especially to family members who do so much for the children. We hope everyone who joined us felt welcome and cherished. You deserve it!
