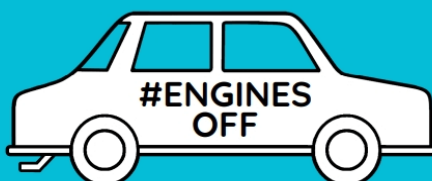
School Meals week commencing: 13th Jan [Menu](#) Week 2
